

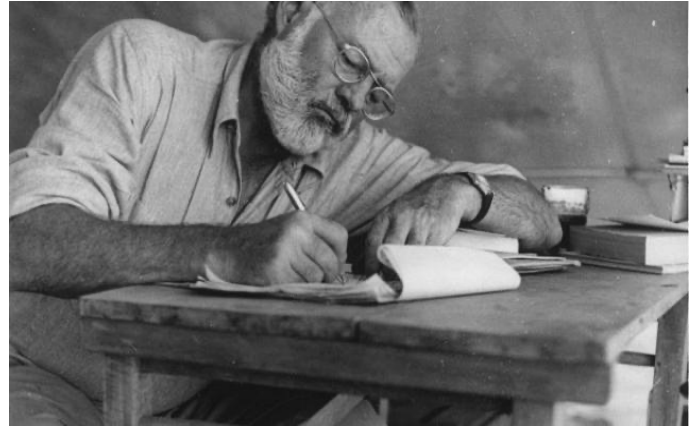

3rd of November

Tour "Following the Steps of Hemingway"

This cultural walking tour explores Madrid through the eyes of Ernest Hemingway, tracing the places he frequented and the stories that inspired his writing. Participants gain insight into his connection with Spain while discovering some of the city's most historic and charming locations



Flamenco and Percussion Workshop (dancing optional)

Experience the passion and energy of Spanish culture through an interactive flamenco workshop in Madrid. Tour "The Madrid of Almodovar"

Bernabeu Stadium Tour

During the tour, they'll see the trophies, the state-of-the-art sensory room, the changing rooms, the home team's dressing room, and the players' tunnel leading to the pitch.
